RACE 1 – LADBROKES PACE – 2180 METRES

MASTER MILO was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

JUST A GEM raced greenly over the concluding stages and shifted ou contacting the sulky of MARISOL around the final turn.

A warning was issued to DELTA CENTURIAN which hung in and contacted marker pegs whilst giving ground.

After beginning satisfactorily BETTOR BLAST NZ has been reinstated in the mobile draw.

RACE 2 – FIND US ON FACEBOOK STAKES – 1892 METRES

ON MY OATH stepped and lead the event before surrendering the lead to JUNIPER worked forward in the middle stages.

ONE OFF NZ stood flat footed at the start and took no competitive part in the event. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in standing starts.

AITUTAKI stood flat footed at the start and took no competitive part in the event. The gelding has been placed right out of the draw in standing starts

ON MY OATH was held up and unable to be fully tested

KARALTA COURAGE underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 54 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down for a period of 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

THE BIG DIG underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 173 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down until completion of a satisfactory trial.

Driver M Jones (PINK PONDER) was cautioned for racing inside a marker peg.

After beginning satisfactorily KIKKIMI has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

RACE 3 – BIG 4 ULVERSTONE PACE – 2180 METRES

BOLD CENTURIAN was caught wide early before working around the field to race outside the leader. The gelding then obtained a trail before being pulled up after suffering a flat tyre.

Driver G Rattray (WHISKEY AND RYE) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR168(1)(a). Particulars were that he allowed his horse to contact the wheel of BOLD CENTURIAN flattening his tyre.

HURRIKANE KIWI was tightened and checked when WHISKEY AND RYE shifted in after contacting a tyre.

RACE 4 – WILLIAM ADAMS STAKES – 2180 METRES

THE DUDE NZ broke free of interference and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

STEVIE JOLT and WHATTA GOOD REASON locked wheels momentarily entering the back straight the final time.

STORMY SANZ worked forward in the early stages to race outside the leader.

RACE 5 – WYNYARD VETERINARY CLINIC STAKES – 2500 METRES

SOMEDAN galloped out and will continue to be right out of the draw in future standing start events.

BIG GEM MONTANA broke its headcheck and was pulled up out of the event. The gear was inspected and was found to be in satisfactory condition.

RAMBLEON broke its hind hopple carrying strap and was pulled up out of the event. The gear was inspected and was found to be in satisfactory condition.

NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ tired to be beaten in excess of 83 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

LOYOLA TRIOS tired to be beaten in excess of 97 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 6 – DOWLING MCCARTHY TYRES STAKES – 2180 METRES

LONGNWINDINGROAD was out of position at the start and will continue to be out of the draw in future mobile events.

LITTLEBITOFMAGIC was out of position at the start and will continue to be right out of the draw in future mobile events.

DON HESTON showed gate speed to lead the event and then commenced to contact his own wheels and overrace. Trainer B Yole undertook to take remedial action to the set up of the cart used on this horse to prevent a recurrence.

MAJOR DAVVIN pulled hard during the event and was held up early before gaining clear running close to the line.

HOT EMBERS gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 42 metres.

RACE 7 – IMPRESS PRINT & DESIGN STAKES – 1892 METRES

DEVIL OF TYNE galloped out and has been placed on his last chance in the standing start draw.

MAYWYNS JEWEL galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

MOZASU NZ galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

JOHN RICHARD galloped out and will continue to be out of the draw in future standing starts.

PROFICIENT NZ was checked and raced roughly when LORIMERTYRRELL shifted off the rails racing into the back straight the first time.

BEE SEVENTEEN was held up and unable to be fully tested.

After beginning satisfactorily BEE SEVENTEEN has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

RACE 8 – BECOME A MEMBER STAKES – 2180 METRES

MY ULTIMATE ROMEO shifted out shortly after the start inconveniencing ASHLEYS BLUE CHIP

GUYS BETTOR BET galloped out and will continue to be out of the draw in standing start events.

MY ULTIMATE ROMEO pulled hard during the event.

KEEP PLAYING reared as the start was effected.

WRITTEN IN SILK hung out and raced roughly during the event.
