RACE 1 – BURNIE TROPHY CENTRE STAKES – 2180 METRES

Permission was granted for a shadow roll to be added to the gear of JO DINA however during the event this mare continually jumped a shadow just after the home turn severely checking CINOCAL JAMANE on the first occasion. No action was taken against the mare.

CINOCAL JAMANE worked forward three wide to race outside the leader after being severely checked behind JO DINA then gained a trail when SLINGSHOT worked forward to take over that position.

BOLTNMACH gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 41 metres.

Driver C Castles (KEEP PLAYING) reported that his tyre deflated during the event.

RACE 2 – BHRC THORATE INCENTIVE – 2180 METRES

BOLD CENTURIAN contacted his own wheel shortly after the start causing him to break - has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

GAMEOFCHANCE broke shortly after the start and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

RACE 3 – JENSEN'S QUALITY METALWORKS STAKES – 2180 METRES

The all clear was held on this race to allow Stewards to review the replays pertaining to the start. After viewing the films All Clear was given on the judge's numbers.

IMAGE OF STARZZZ reared at the start was affected and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

GUIDO DA SIENA NZ swung sideways at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

TURQUOISE STRIDE galloped out and will continue out of the standing start draw.

BEE SEVENTEEN galloped out then was checked soon after the start and broke. This gelding has been placed out of the draw in future standing, starts

After beginning satisfactorily OZZIE MAJOR has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

KARALTA DAZZLER was held up and unable to be fully tested.

OZZIE MAJOR was held up and unable to be fully tested.

GUIDO DA SIENA NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 34 metres. No abnormalities were detected.

RACE 4 – NORM BRITTON MEMORIAL STAKES – 2180 METRES

PROSECUTION WITNESS NZ galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

PROFICIENT NZ was inconvenienced after the start by the galloping PROSECUTION WITNESS. The gelding worked around the field three wide to race outside the leader.

NINE DIAMONDS hung out and broke racing around the first turn taking no further competitive part in the event. The mare has been placed on her last chance to race truly.

SEA HAWKE was severely checked around the first turn when NINE DIAMONDS broke.

A warning was issued on the manners of ON MY OATH which hung in and contacted marker pegs around the final time.

VAN NIEKERK NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 106 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

Trainer B Yole was fined the sum of \$150 under AHRR273(6)(b) for presenting his horses in gear that was not correctly declared. Stewards considered Mr Yole's recent record under this rule.

RACE 5 – SUE REES MODELLING & DEPORTMENT ACADEMY STAKES – 2180 METRES

BENJAMIN NIADH galloped for a considerable distance after the start and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

ARTYBOY GLENWOOD galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

PICKLE IT worked forward three wide to race outside the leader.

A warning was issued on the manners of IM QUITE AMERICAN who hung in racing into the back straight the final time.

RACE 6 – CAPE VIEW NURSERY STAKES – 1892 METRES

KOLOVOS NZ galloped shortly after the start and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

KENYA NZ galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

JACKSON NEPTUNE pulled hard during the event.

COOL SCOOTER NZ reared as the start was effected and will continue out of the draw in standing starts. The gelding was then inconvenienced by other galloping runners.

SMOOTH DEAL NZ was checked after the start by the galloping KENYA NZ.

After beginning satisfactorily SMOOTH DEAL NZ has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

RACE 7 – 7BU BURNIE CUP – 2789 METRES

BETTABROWN TIGER was fractious before the start then stood flat footed as the start was effected. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events and has been stood down from standing starts until the completion of a satisfactory standing start trial.

WHERE YA BIN NZ galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

KUYOMI NZ led early before surrendering the lead to COLBY SANZ which worked forward to take over that position.

BETTABROWN TIGER hung out and checked KUZMA after travelling 800 metres. The gelding was then retired from the event and underwent a post-race veterinary examination at the request of the driver which revealed lameness in the off-side hind leg. BETTABROWN TIGER has been stood down for a period of 28 days and until the receipt of a veterinary clearance.

After beginning satisfactorily CHECK IN NZ has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

After beginning satisfactorily KUZMA has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

RACE 8 – EN VOGUE MODELLING AGENCY STAKES – 1892 METRES

EUROKING galloped for a considerable distance after the start and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

ROCKS ROY swung sideways as the start was effected and trailed the field throughout. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

SZABOLSKI LEIS was inconvenienced after the start by a galloping runner then worked forward three wide to race outside the leader.

MAJOR DAVVIN was severely checked when ROCKS ROY swung sideways at the start.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES PACE – 2180 METRES

Stewards intend to inquire into the whip use of T Ford (WRITTEN IN SILK) rounding the home bend and in the home straight.

Driver C Crossland (MONTANA FLASH) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR162(1)(j). Particulars were that he failed to maintain his position behind the mobile until the start was effected.

Tasmanian Trotting Club 20 Jan 2023 - Race 9 CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE

Driver N Ford (SO ART I NZ) was suspended for two Tasmanian race dates after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR165(1)(a). Particulars were that when racing around the first turn he failed to give sufficient clearance to the horse racing to his

inside (PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ) with that horse then contacting and dislodging a marker pole. Stewards took into account the manners of both horses and Mr Fords guilty plea when assessing penalty

Tasmanian Trotting Club 20 Jan 2023 - Race 9 CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE

Driver O Weidenbach (PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ) was cautioned under AHRR163(1)(c)(ii) for allowing her horse to contact marker pegs racing into the home straight the final time.
