RACE 1 – CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE – 2090 METRES

KARALTA DAZZLER – Caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

TURQUOISE STRIDE – Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

TEE JAY CEE – Sulky contacted near the 200 when giving ground under pressure.

JACKS N JAZZ NZ – Tendered to over-race. Broke gait when racing in restricted room near the 200, after contacting the sulky of TEE JAY CEE, which was giving ground at the time.

RACE 2 - PRYDES EASIFEED PACE. - 1609 METRES

PLEASE SHUDDUP NZ – Tended to over-race.

KIAVINO STRIDE – Pulled hard in the lead. Momentarily tightened rounding the final turn, shifted in and contacted markers.

THE DEMOCRAT – Out of position when the start was affected. Driver A McDonough was reprimanded for failing to keep THE DEMOCRAT in position until the start [AHR Rule 162(1)(j)].

STAVROS THE TERROR NZ – Tired out of the event beaten over 60 metres. A post-race Veterinary inspection failed to find any obvious abnormalities. Based on STAVROS

THE TERROR NZ's recent poor record, the gelding was stood down from racing for a period of two (2) weeks, and before returning to racing must satisfactorily complete two (2) consecutive qualifying trials.

AMILLION PROMISES – Placed on its last chance to race truly after breaking gait approaching the first turn when being angled down toward the markers. Had difficulty in securing clear running over the final stages of the event.

RACE 3 – MORE CONSULTING PACE – 2090 METRES

SURPRISE WRITER – Sulky contacted leaving the 150 metres.

VAN NIEKERK NZ – Held up for clear running until well into the home straight for the run to the finish.

REMEMBER ME NOW NZ – Broke in the early stages of the score-up, however was able to fill its allotted position within the required parameters.

OUR RUBY ROSE – Held up entering the home straight, when shifting ground searching for clear running near the 150 became unbalanced, brushed a sulky wheel, and shifted inside a marker. Driver D Ford was subsequently reprimanded for the careless manner he shifted ground [AHR Rule 168(1)(a)].

RACE 4 – SMITHAWARDS PACE – 2090 METRES

BLACKJACK JIM – Tendered to over-race. Gave ground from the 400.

CARDINAL SIN NZ – Locked wheels with IDEN BLACK PRINCE approaching the first turn.

LALASA – Had difficulty in securing clear running over the concluding stages, particularly racing between the 400 and 200, due to BLACKJACK JIM giving ground.

IDEN BLACK PRINCE – Locked wheels with CARDINAL SIN NZ approaching the first turn, became unbalanced and broke gait. As a result of this incident the near-side sulky wheel was damaged and as such IDEN BLACK PRINCE was pulled up out of the event near the 1500.

General: Racing into the first turn CARDINAL SIN NZ and IDEN BLACK PRINCE locked wheels. Stewards after review, were satisfied that no one driver nor horse were culpable for the incident, as movement from several runners had all contributed. Stewards took no action other than to note the circumstances.

RACE 5 – LHT CUP HEAT THREE – 2579 METRES

MAJOR GENERALJUJON – Will be excluded from the barrier draw in future standing start events after failing, once again, to begin in the required manner.

TAROONA BROMAC NZ – Placed on its last chance in the draw for races conducted under standing start condition after failing to begin in the required manner. This contributed to the gelding being beaten more than 80 metres.

BEAST MODE – Tended to over-race.

WYATTFLYNN – Placed on its last chance to race competitively after giving ground to be beaten approximately 70 metres.

ARDEN ROANOKE NZ – Galloped away after the strands were released. Due to its poor record in the regard, the gelding will be drawn on the extreme outside in future standing start events (RODS). Subjected to a post-race Veterinary Examination. On inspection, ARDEN ROANOKE NZ was found to have a laceration to its medial side forearm. Stewards acting under Veterinary advice, stood ARDEN ROANOKE NZ down from racing until connections forward on a Veterinary clearance.

AQUA SANCTA NZ – Will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw for races conducted under standing start condition after failing to begin in the required manner.

WOULD YOU MIND NZ – Momentarily raced rough near the 1500 when racing at the rear of the field.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES TASMANIA CUP HEAT TWO – 2579 METRES

YIANNI– Placed on its last chance in the draw for races conducted under standing start condition after failing to begin in the required manner. This contributed to the gelding being beaten approximately 80 metres.

STRAVINSKY– Placed on its last chance in the draw for races conducted under standing start condition after failing to begin in the required manner.

THE SHALLOWS – Placed on its last chance in the draw for races conducted under standing start condition after failing to begin in the required manner. This contributed to the gelding being beaten in excess of 80 metres.

General: Trainer E Stewart was fined \$100 for failing to notify A McDonough, by the required time, as the driver of WHERES THE GOLD [AHR Rule 210].

RACE 7 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

CASTOR TROY – Driver R Ashwood was reprimanded for failing to have CASTOR TROY up and in position when the start was effected [AHR Rule 162(1)(h)].

MILITARY MAN NZ – Placed on its last chance to race competitively after giving ground to be beaten over 70 metres.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN LABOR PACE – 1609 METRES

OZZIE MAJOR – Placed on its last chance to race truly after breaking gait leaving the 400.
