RACE 1 – CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE – 2090 METRES

JACKS N JAZZ NZ delayed the start due to a gear adjustment.

TACTILE SENSATION broke free of interference as the field raced into the back straight on the first occasion. This gelding has been stood down for a period of fourteen days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

JACKS N JAZZ NZ, COPPICE and SON OF RAYSON were checked as a result of the galloping TACTILE SENSATION.

IDEN BLACK PRINCE utilised the sprint lane.

KICK IT TO JACK driver Nathan Ford reported that he sustained a flat tyre during the running of this event.

JACKS N JAZZ NZ was placed back in the draw for future mobile start events.

RACE 2 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 1609 METRES

MISS BARTY trainer Brett Bailey advised Stewards at 4:15PM that this mare was suffering from an injury detected when preparing to transport the horse to tonight's meeting.

THEUGLYSISTER utilised the sprint lane.

QUEEN TREACHERIE NZ shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Driver Allan McDonough pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR162(1)(y) in that he failed to meet the sectional time requirements for this event. Mr McDonough was fined the sum of \$100.

RACE 3 – CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE – 1609 METRES

VIVID STRIDE caught wide early and restrained to the rear of the field.

STAROFREMEMBERANCE caught wide early and raced roughly for a few strides before being restrained to the rear of the field.

MISTA EAGLE utilised the sprint lane.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090 METRES

NERO STRIDE pulled hard throughout while racing outside the leader, tiring to be beaten in excess of 51 metres. This gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

HENRY HU NZ gave ground over the concluding stages.

WHEY BETTER utilised the sprint lane.

THE DEMOCRAT was placed back in the mobile start draw.

After receiving a complaint from trainer Ivan Belbin (EYE SEE DOUBLE) Stewards reviewed the driving tactics employed during the early stages of this event by driver Nathan Ford (NERO STRIDE). After hearing evidence from trainer Ivan Belbin, driver Liam Older (EYE SEE DOUBLE), driver Nathan Ford and acting on their own observations, Stewards declined to pursue the matter any further.

RACE 5 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

SLINGSHOT caused a false start early in the score up when a burr pole become dislodged and required adjustment.

PRIDDY EASY broke for a few strides during the early stages of the score up, as this gelding was in position when the field was released no action was taken.

KARALTA DAZZLER caught wide early and restrained to the rear of the field.

PINK PONDER caught wide early and restrained to the rear of the field.

MY ULTIMATE ROMEO gave ground over the concluding stages.

RACE 6 – TYPEFACE PACE – 2090 METRES

PROFICIENT NZ slow out.

ISLAS JOY NZ galloped out. This gelding has been placed outside the draw in future standing start events.

LAVROS MIDAS TOUCH NZ galloped out. This gelding has been placed outside the draw in future standing start events.

WAYONBYE galloped out. This gelding will continue to be placed outside the draw in future standing start events.

IFBUTZANDMAYBES hung in and broke as the field raced around the home turn on the final occasion. This gelding has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

MAJOR GENERALJUJON tired, to be beaten in excess of 53 metres. This gelding has been stood down for a period of fourteen days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 1609 METRES

DON HESTON pulled hard at various stages.

RACE 8 – YOUNG GROUP PACE – 2090 METRES

SHAUN TO THE MAX was held up for clear racing room over the concluding stages.

MONET MONET tired, to be beaten in excess of 73 metres. This mare has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.
